



International Education Program COVID-19 Refund Policy 2021-2022

If you are applying to study at the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board for September 2021 or February 2022 entry as a new or returning student, but are unable/unwilling to travel to Canada before the start of the semester due to the spread of the Coronavirus, the following options regarding registration will be available:

1. You can request to defer your registration to the 2022-2023 entry and a new Letter of Acceptance will be issued.
2. You can request to withdraw your registration. Full tuition refund (less \$500.00 CAD administrative fee) will be granted,

The original refund policy is also still in affect for students unable to attend for reasons other than COVID-19 as described below.

“The tuition fee is not refundable, except for students who are unable to start the program because of documented medical difficulties or student permit rejection - for those conditions an administration fee of \$500.00 CAD will apply.

Students who are found to seriously violate the policies of the International Educational Program or the policies of the school or the laws of the country will be returned home immediately. In this eventuality, the tuition fee is not refundable.”
